The program was split into two streams to cater for two different attendee types:

Stream 1 – Australian companies

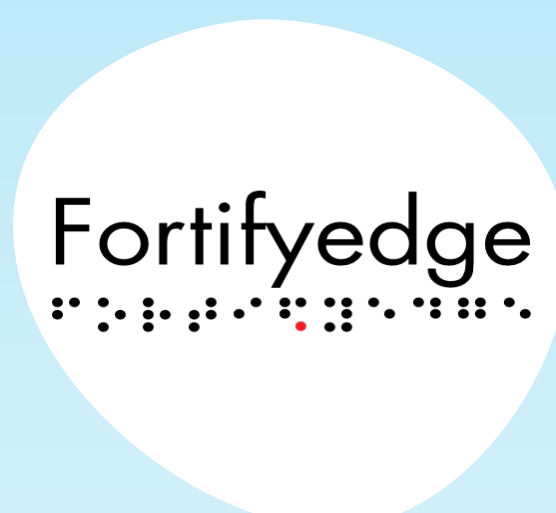
